What is an ADTU?

ADTU stands for Ambulatory Diagnostic and Treatment Unit. ADTUs are designed to address acute issues that could normally be handled in a clinic setting, but require extra time or intervention. The typical ADTU visit lasts 2-4 hours.

Why does the organization need ADTUs?

ADTUs can help alleviate patient traffic across the main medical campus, especially in the Emergency Department. They also help improve patient access to healthcare providers and services. ADTUs allow Michigan Medicine to take care of more urgent patient needs by a Michigan Medicine provider who has access to the patient's medical record and can consult, if necessary, with the Michigan Medicine team.

How is the ADTU different than an urgent care?

Urgent care clinics typically operate on a walk-in basis and offer a limited range of services. ADTUs offer existing patients more services than typically offered in an urgent care setting, performed by Michigan Medicine providers with access to patient records, ensuring continuity of care.

What services are offered at the ADTU?

The ADTU offers a wide range of services including but not limited to: infusion therapy, radiology and ultrasound imaging, lab services, breathing treatments, paracentesis, thoracentesis, abscess incision and drainage.

Who is eligible to use ADTU services?

The ADTU is an option for established Michigan Medicine patients requiring management of an acute condition over a 2 to 6-hour period.

Can the patient call an ADTU and make an appointment?

ADTU appointments can only be requested by a referring Michigan Medicine provider. Appointments are made for the same day whenever possible.
